St. Abbs Harbour is only half a mile from Scoutscoft.

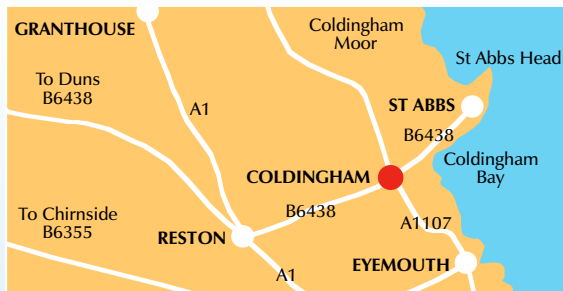

**From the South** on the A1, head up the A1107 and turn off at the Eyemouth junction. Stay on the A1107 until you reach the village of Coldingham. Take the B6438 heading towards St Abbs. On route, ScoutsCrest Holiday Centre is situated on the right hand side.

**From the North**, stay on the A1 until you reach the Reston junction. Take the B6438 into the village of Coldingham, stay on the B6438 heading towards St Abbs. On route, ScoutsCrest Holiday Centre is situated on the right hand side.
